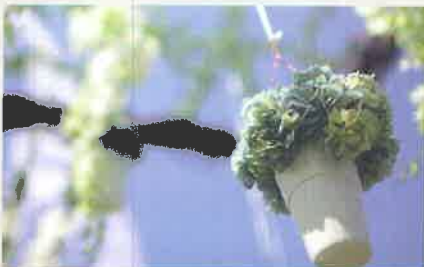
Celebration at Khayangan Estate, Bali
